Our new Erasmus Plus KA2 Project Online colour therapy: Treat post-traumatic disorder through art, officially started on May 1st 2021 and continued with several virtual meetings. The meeting brought together all four partners – the project coordinator, GESEME, and the project partners, STANDO LTD from Cyprus, SC MIXT SOURCE MANAGEMENT SRL from Romania, ULUSLARARASI ARASTIRMA INOVASYON EGITIM VE GIRISIMCILIK DERNEGI from Turkey. Partners presented their own organizations. Through our project we aim to develop an innovative training package for health VET trainers to use as a basic tool to train health support staff to familiarise them with PTSD and increase their skills and competencies to recognise and treat individuals with traumatic disorders through proper strategies for de-escalating stressful interactions.

Since the beginning of the project, partners have been working on the completion of intellectual outputs, the creation of visuality for the project, reaching target audiences and interested stakeholders. The project activities and outputs were presented and intellectual outputs and activities were also discussed during KOM and other virtual meetings. During the KOM the project coordinator presented management responsibilities and tasks. The partners also agreed on an agenda that would focus on producing quality results.

The project has been successful in the Erasmus+ call and consequently co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union for its 2-years' implementation.
