- This 5-days of training was intended for VET health trainers, including mental health professionals who wish to learn more about PTD.
- We have discussed all the modules in IO1. Now, VET health trainers should know what PTD is, what art therapy is and how they can approach to PTD by using art therapy. We also received feedback from VET health trainers about the IO1 and IO2 (i.e., virtual reality scenarios).
